The Ministry of Human Resources, Culture, Tourism, and Development is pleased to announce the trial operation of a **public bus service connecting Ngarchelong, Ngaraard, and Koror** as part of our continuing efforts to build a reliable public transportation system for Palau.

Residents in the northern states often travel long distances to reach schools, workplaces, government services, and businesses located in Koror. This new bus service is designed to improve access and provide a more affordable transportation option for communities in the northern corridor of Babeldaob. The **morning service begins in Ngarchelong at 6:30 AM**, picking up passengers at several locations in Ngarchelong and Ngaraard before arriving in Koror around **7:45 to 7:55 AM**. This allows students, workers, and government employees to reach their destinations in time for the start of the workday. In the afternoon, the **return bus departs Koror at approximately 5:10 PM**, transporting passengers back through Ngaraard and returning to Ngarchelong in the early evening.

This service is currently operating as a **trial route**, allowing the Ministry to evaluate ridership demand, travel times, and operational efficiency along the northern corridor.

The information collected during this trial will help guide future improvements and expansion of Palau's national public transportation network.

We encourage residents of Ngarchelong and Ngaraard to utilize the service and share their feedback as we work together to build a transportation system that better serves our communities.
